The National Gallery has brought together some of Van Gogh's most loved paintings from across the globe, including some that are rarely seen in public. They will be paired together with his extraordinary drawings.

Over just two years in the south of France, Van Gogh revolutionised his style in a symphony of poetic colour and texture. He was inspired by poets, writers and artists. We look at this time in Arles and Saint-Rémy as a decisive period in his career. His desire to tell stories produced a landscape of poetic imagination and romantic love on an ambitious scale.

See up-close his 'Starry Night over the Rhône' (1888, Musée d'Orsay) and 'The Yellow House' (1888, Van Gogh Museum), as well as the National Gallery's 'Sunflowers' (1888) and 'Van Gogh's Chair' (1889), amongst many others.

GETTING THERE: We will catch the 10.53 train from Oxted to Victoria, arriving 11.32. Then the tube to Embankment from where the National Gallery is a few minutes' walk. We have tickets for 1.00pm so we will have time for a coffee and sandwich before going into the exhibition.
