In 1988 British model Naomi Campbell made history when she became the first Black model to secure the cover of *Vogue* Paris (now *Vogue* France)– aged just 18. Campbell credits this historic moment to the support of French designer Yves Saint Laurent, and the efforts of the talented Black models who came before her and were determined to create a space for themselves in the fashion industry.

This is the first exhibition of its kind exploring the extraordinary career of Naomi Campbell, through the work of leading global designers and photographers her creative collaborations, activism and far-reaching cultural impact is celebrated.
