The Wallace Collection is home to one of the most significant collections of fine and decorative arts in the world. Highlights include oil paintings from the 14th to the late 19th centuries by artists such as Titian, Velázquez, Rubens and Van Dyck; royal arms and armour; and one of the finest collections of 18th-century French paintings and decorative arts.

GETTING THERE: We will catch the 11.20 train from Oxted to London Bridge, arriving 11.53. Then the Jubilee line to Bond Street followed by a 10 minute walk to Manchester Square where the Wallace Collection is situated. We have tickets for 1.30 pm so we will have time for a coffee and sandwich before going into the exhibition. The tour will take about an hour.

Please let me know if you decide to make your own travel arrangements and meet me in the entrance at 1.15pm.

For those of you who may be interested there is the *Grayson Perry: Delusions of Grandeur* exhibition on at the time of our visit. The exhibition will include ceramics, tapestries, furniture and collage, displayed alongside some of the Wallace Collection's masterpieces which helped inspire and shape Grayson Perry's vision for this landmark exhibition." *You will need to purchase your own ticket and early booking is advised. I suggest 3.00pm as tour finishes approximately 2.30pm.*
