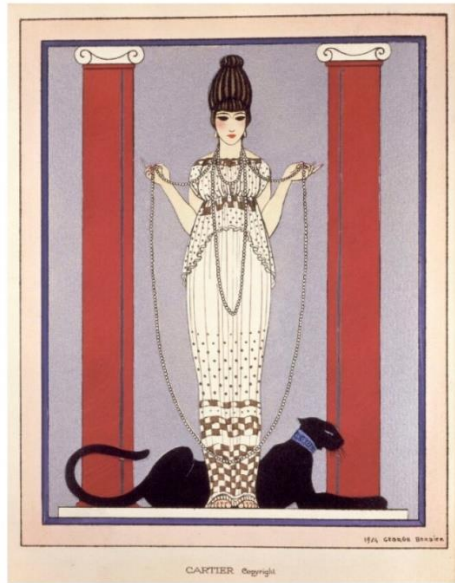


Illustration for Panthère advertisement by George Barbier for Cartier, 1914. (Wikipedia)

This major exhibition features more than 350 objects, including precious jewels, historic gemstones, iconic watches and clocks, which chart the evolution of Cartier's legacy of art, design, and craftsmanship since the turn of the 20th century.
