This visit links with our Study Day in February 2026 which will be about the Art of the Mughal World.

This major exhibition celebrates the extraordinary creative output and internationalist culture of the Golden Age of the Mughal Court (about 1560 – 1660) during the reigns of its most famous emperors: Akbar, Jahangir and Shah Jahan.

The great age of Mughal art spanned the reigns of these three emperors. Hindu and Muslim artists and craftsmen from the northern regions of the Indian subcontinent worked with Iranian masters in the royal workshops. Their very different traditions were combined to produce a radically new, and rapidly evolving style of art for the court.

GETTING THERE: We will catch the 10.53 train from Oxted to Victoria, arriving 11.32. Then the tube to South Kensington. We have tickets for 1.00pm and 1.10pm so we will have time for a coffee and sandwich before going into the exhibition.
